- Medication administration
- Community participation – e.g. medical appointments, shopping, social and recreational outings
- Transport

The successful candidate will:

- Undertake shift work, including overnight sleepover shifts and weekend work on a rotational roster
- Hold a current Qld driver's licence
- Current first aid and CPR
- Criminal history Screening (yellow card) and
- Working with Children check (blue card)
- A certificate III or IV in Disability or Individual Support or a qualification similar in the community services sector is highly desirable
